But where do we go for the times that we may need **emergency spiritual help**? Many times the need for **emergency medical** and **spiritual** help occur together ... in life-threatening situations due to sickness or an accident.

That's why I hope you'll **cut out the following table of Priest phone numbers** and **carry it with you** and **post it for your family** so they'll know who to call in emergencies.

When that happens, we should have a plan to bring **emergency spiritual help** to those in need!

Please, when **you know you're going into** the hospital for surgery and will undergo anesthesia, go to **Confession** and receive the **Anointing of the Sick** before you go in!

But when an emergency occurs and a **person is in danger of death**, call for a **Priest right away** to come and administer **the Last Rites to the person**.

Confirmation Corner

For Wednesday, March 30 The 7 sacraments: Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders and Matrimony.

The 7 gifts of the of the Holy Spirit: Wisdom, Understanding, Right Judgment, Knowledge, Courage, Reverence, and Wonder and Awe (Fear of the Lord) The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are given to us by God so that we can follow Him and be inspired by Him.

The 12 fruits of the Holy Spirit: Charity, Joy, Peace, Patience, Goodness, Kindness, Long Suffering (generosity), Humility (Gentleness), Faithfulness, Modesty, Contenance (self control) and Chastity. The fruits of the Holy Spirit are how we are perfected by the gifts so that we show to the world and that we are a reflection of God.

For Sunday, April 3rd Know the parts of the mass.

Continue to study for your confirmation exam and your Bishop interview using the two main study guides we handed out in class.

The confirmation test is currently scheduled for April 10th.

Remember to keep Palm Sunday and Saturday April 16th and 17th free for our class project. The Eucharist was instituted at the Passover feast and the class project of setting up and serving the Seder Meal not only provides service hours but also serves as an educational experience. It is the only service project that we require the group to do and permission not to participate must be given by Fr Deering.

Confirmation is set for Wednesday, May 4, 2011 at 7:00 PM

A Baptismal certificate must be on file at the church office by **April 6** for your child to be confirmed. If confirmation candidates do not have a Baptism Certificate on file, at the church, call the office at 631-9398. If the certificates are out of state or out of country more time will be needed to get copies so please allow enough lead time to meet the deadline.
