We are an Outreach Ministry comprised of women from St. Elizabeth Ann Seton who want to serve our parish. We fall under the direction of our Pastor and the LAS Officers and we are named as an extension of the Ladies Altar Sodality as a Guild which began in 2009 and organized by Donna Wallace through the inspiration of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

Through guidance of the Holy Spirit we will share our Catholic Faith with those of our Parish who reach out to us in times of need.

Our goal is to pray and lend a helping hand to those in despair who have sadness from losses and bereavement and to console those who are burdened by confinement, loneliness and sickness.

- We provide baby blankets for infant Baptisms and gifts to adolescent children of our parish.
- We provide a light meal and visit the homes of the family of deceased parishioners during time of mourning.
- We take gift bags of candy and goodies to parishioners who are in the nursing homes, assisted living and homebound during major holidays.
- We visit the sick when requested, mail cards, provide rosaries and religious articles to the sick and homebound and try to bring comfort and peace to those in need through prayer. If you or your immediate family are sick and want to be on our Mass announcement list you may call the parish office.
- Assist in all Ladies Altar Sodality Parish functions when needed.

The Outreach Ministry of Our Lady of Guadalupe is funded by the Ladies Altar Sodality through proceeds from St. Joseph's Altar and Bake Sale and the annual Spaghetti Dinner whereas we receive 10% from each event.

Our Outreach Ministry presently meets quarterly and our current coordinator is Caroline Gerson.
