ATTENTION!! FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION PARENTS
 ***New PSR policy effective 5/2/2017
Fr. Johnson has approved the following PSR Policy changes.
 Students enrolling in St. Elizabeth Ann Seton PSR program for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation classes must be registered members of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and regularly attending Holy Mass at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton. Students must have been registered in PSR the prior year (their 1st and 7th grade year). They may only miss 6 of the 30 classes in 1st & 2nd grade and 7th & 8th grade to receive those Sacraments. Parents must attend the parent meeting for those children preparing for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. All children, 1st through 12th grade, should be attending PSR Catholic Religious Education Classes.
 All students attending PSR classes and leaving without attending Holy Mass is unacceptable.

New St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish Council 2018-2020

We are developing new Parish Councils in both St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and St. Henry Parishes. A Parish Council is meant to be a consultative body which strives to discern the movement of the Holy Spirit among God's people in the Parish. The Parish Council's purpose is to assist the Pastor/Administrator in his leadership role through discernment. Under the authority of the Pastor/Administrator, the Parish Council may be asked to investigate, ponder, and make recommendations about matters in the context of prayer and openness to the Holy Spirit so that at all times the common good will prevail. The Parish Council should, as a body, foster unity and a sense of community in the parish and coordinate all parish activities in a manner that will best serve the interests of the parish.

After some prayer and reflection, I would like to ask, that those of you who are interested in considering serving or feel called to serve on the Parish Council, please complete the forms which are placed in the vestibule and put your name, email address, phone number, a brief summary of why you are interested in serving and what you feel you could contribute to the parish council by your membership. All submissions should be personally returned to Fr. Johnson by August 26, 2018. I will review all submissions and act accordingly.

Let us pray that the Holy Spirit will lead and guide us all in this process.
