

"From the Pastor's Desk"

1, 2, 3 ... Go! Yes, 3 days from now we will all go... into the Holy Season of Lent!

It's a holy season because it's during this 40-day period that we try in a special way to grow in holiness by detaching ourselves from worldly things and concentrating on renewing our relationship with God and with those around us.

A very meaningful way to begin the Forty Days of Lent is to receive ashes on your forehead on Ash Wednesday. This is a profound act of mortification whereby we acknowledge that our bodies will one day die and eventually decompose into nothing but ashes.

This helps us to see that taking care of our **body** in this life is far less important than taking care of our immortal **soul**, which will never die and will live forever in eternity either with God or apart from God ... based on our own free choice.

Ashes will be distributed at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton on Wednesday, February 10th during the 6:30 AM Mass and the 6:00 PM Mass.

Remember to abstain from **all meat** and have just **one meal** on Ash Wednesday ... and on each of the 7 Friday's of Lent!

A powerful prayer to be offered during Lent is known as the **Stations of the Cross**, which we will offer as follows: Friday, **February 12th** @ St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Friday, **February 19th** @ St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Friday, **February 26th** @ St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Friday, **March 4th** @ St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Friday, March 11th The Passion movie @ SEAS Friday, **March 18th** @ St. Henry The Stations will also be offered Wednesdays at 6 at St. Henry.

After praying the Friday Stations, you're invited to come to the Parish Hall to partake of a meatless meal and have

conversation with other Parishioners. Please try to come to 6:30 AM Mass at St. Elizabeth

Ann Seton during the weekdays days of Lent to tap into the grace of the once for all Sacrifice of Jesus on Calvary.

Also try participating in the Forty Days for Life campaign, praying the daily Rosary, reading the Black Book and *Rediscovering Jesus* daily meditations and quiet prayer. May you have a Holy Lent. Love, Father Deering
