"From the Pastor's Desk"

If you were a salesman, and the income you received was a 10% commission on everything you sold, I'm sure you'd keep a close watch on all the paychecks you received throughout the year to be sure you got all the commissions you earned.

In the a similar way, back in January, you promised to give to this Parish a certain percentage of your income as a sign of your gratitude to God for being able to work and as the way of sustaining the good work we do together as Parish.

So, as we enter the second half of this year, I ask you to check on how well you're doing in keeping your pledge. To assist you in this you'll receive this week a **Summary Statement of Contributions** for the first 26 weeks of the year.

At the bottom of your statement you'll be able to see the **Pledged Amount**, which is the amount you prayerfully decided to give to the Church for this year with God's target being **between 5% and 10%** of your annual income.

Your **Total Contribution** to the Church is the sum of the money you've given for both **Offertory** and **Building Fund**.

See if your **Total Contributions equal ½ or more of your Annual Pledge** here at mid-year.

If there's **any shortage** because you've been away traveling or vacationing, please consider making up your missing contributions in the weeks ahead so as to meet your promised Pledge by year-end.

If any of you **had to take a cut in pay** or lost some scheduled hours of work, rest assured that you will not be expected to maintain your previously pledged amount ... just try to pay your chosen percentage of your reduced income.

If you are **new to the Parish** or for some reason didn't pledge back in January, please join with our Parish family in demonstrating your gratitude to God for His many blessings and your desire to support the operation of our Parish by contributing regularly to our Offertory and / or Building Fund.

To **those of you who are faithfully giving to the Church ... I thank you sincerely!** Because of your care and generosity, we're paying all our bills and have even been able to make enhancements to our facilities!

Know that God sees this and will come right back and favor you with special blessings.

To **those of you who are not giving to the Church ...** I invite you to begin the practice ... it's **God's plan** for financially funding His Church.
