REGISTER FOR FLOCKNOTE For St Elizabeth Communication!!

We are going to begin using Flocknote as a communication tool for the parish. Flocknote uses email and text. Everyone who wants to receive these texts and emails will need to register.
To register, from your cell phone, text the code SEASBHAM (all caps) to 84576. Afterwards, you will receive a confirmation text message that includes a link to the registration form. This registration form will ask for: your name, email, phone number and any group(s) for which you want to register to receive texts and emails (Extraordinary Ministers, Ushers, Adult-Ed, etc ...). Once finished, you will be automatically placed in the parish group text and any group(s) you decide to join, and you will receive a text message confirming your registration. This registration will not impact any existing group communications (Knights of Columbus or Ladies Altar Sodality). If you need any assistance, let us know and we'll be happy to help.
