"From the Pastor's Desk"

You've heard the request many times to **Pray for Vocations!**

It's a sincere request from myself and the universal Church to pray for God's Holy Spirit to actualize his call within the hearts of the people.

The customary understanding of this request was to pray for more men to respond to God's call to the **Priesthood**.

Certainly there's a great need in many places for more Priests to lead and feed the People of God.

But there's also a need for more people to hear and respond to God's call to **Holy Matrimony** ... for it too is a graced vocation!

Yes, there are **3 possible ways** that **God may call you to live out your life** ... either remaining **Single** or getting **Married** or serving the Church in a **Religious** role.

And the best one of these three is the one God calls you to!

Single people are sustained in their vocation simply through partaking of the repeatable Sacraments of **Eucharist, Confession** and **Anointing**.

Married couples are sustained in their vocation by receiving the special one-time Sacrament of **Matrimony**. It's here that God opens up a whole new channel of grace to preserve a husband and wife in unity and the raising of their children.

Priests are sustained in their vocation by receiving the special one-time Sacrament of **Holy Orders**. It's here that God opens up a whole new channel of grace to preserve them in their work of guiding and guarding the faithful while remaining celibate, obedient to the Bishop and living simply in the world.

As we prepare to welcome **Pope Francis** to Philadelphia in late September to preside over **the Synod on the Family** ... let's broaden our prayers for vocations to include all the men and women that God is calling to be married.

Never in history has this been more needed than right now as the Family is under a strong attack by Satan and the world.

For example, of the 21 couples who participated in the **Catholic Engaged Encounter** weekend last week ...

9 of the couples were living together before marriage! Now since statistics show that **75% of couples who live together before marriage get divorced**, many of our young people are setting themselves up for disaster by following the culture and living together outside of marriage.

Happily, as a result of this weekend many of the couples on this Engagement Retreat made the decision to go to Confession and begin to live chastely until their Wedding Day.

So, please double your prayers for **Vocations** ... so that both **Priests** and **Married Couples** to be sustained in their call. Prayers and Blessings, Father Deering
