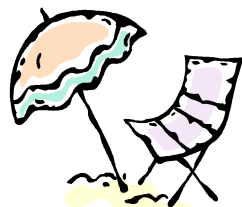
Class Reunion!

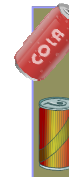
