AROUND OUR PARISH

New PSR Policy — Effective 5/2/2017
 Students enrolling in St. Elizabeth Ann Seton PSR program for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation classes must be registered members of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and regularly attending Holy Mass here. Students must have been registered in PSR the prior year (their 1st grade and 7th grade year). They must attend at least 3/4's of the classes both in 1st and 2nd grade and 7th and 8th grade to receive those Sacraments. Parents must attend the parent meeting for those children preparing for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. All children 1st –12th grade should be attending PSR Catholic Religious Education Classes. All students attending PSR classes and leaving without attending Holy Mass is unacceptable.

Modest Dress for Holy Mass
 We are asking that everyone dress appropriately for Holy Mass. Certainly those who serve on the altar as Lay Ministers should be careful in their choice of clothing. Our focus should be on God and the Mass not what someone else is wearing. Blame Adam and Eve! Ever since their fall, clothing has been a spiritual issue. To quote Father Stubeda, pastor of St. Pius X in Glencoe, Minn: "We like seeing you in church — just not so much of you"
