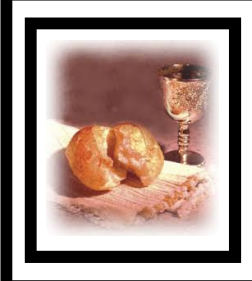

"From the Pastor's Desk"

Before he stepped down Pope Emeritus Benedict said, "The crisis of Fatherhood which we are living through today constitutes the heart of the human crisis that is threatening us."

When you look at all the issues that we're debating ... whether it's same-sex marriage, divorce and remarriage, indissolubility of marriage, contraception and others ... we see something they all share in common ... we see they all share a rejection of the mystery of Fatherly love.

This has a way of snuffing out the life and fruit of the father ... and the mother as well.

The fidelity of fatherhood is rejected through divorce and the fruitfulness of fatherhood is rejected through abortion and contraception and the mystery of Divine Fatherhood is suppressed and distorted through same-sex marriage.

It's because God wanted to reveal to us that we are not just receiving His pity and His pardon ...

but His power and His own paternity.

It's this that allows us to look upon Christ and realize that He came to assume what is ours so as to give us what is His.

Today we celebrate Father's Day, where we specifically reverence Fathers for the awesome job they do in providing for and protecting the human family.

Their imperfect but passionate efforts witness to the perfect love of God the Father of all.

Whether you're a father or a father-figure ... the role you play is crucial in forming and guiding children through the many distortions the world presents to them today.

And wives and mothers you too play a crucial role in encouraging and affirming the authority and leadership of human fatherhood.

Let's pray that God's permanent love and bountiful fruitfulness would be visible through Fathers everywhere.

It also strengthens the marital bond by fostering psychological and spiritual marital intimacy between spouses. In keeping with the times, the Church has newer methods of NFP which are simple, effective and objective. The Marquette Model of NFP uses a fertility monitor to measure a woman's urinary hormones to accurately predict her time of fertility to achieve or avoid a pregnancy with 98-99% efficacy.
