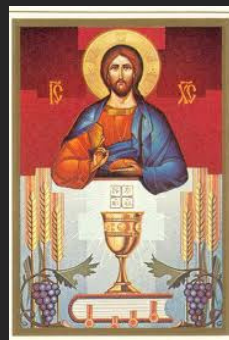

Hey folks, Have you ever wanted to learn how to evangelize? Ever been in a situation where you wanted to say something about Jesus, or your Catholic Faith, but just didn't know how to get started? Well, we've got what you need. The Office of the New Evangelization is conducting a **"Basic Evangelization Workshop"** at **St. Peter the Apostle parish** in Birmingham on **July 10th and 11th.**

The workshop will be conducted by St. Paul Street Evangelization - an organization that has chapters all throughout the U.S. that specialize in street evangelization. But, while street evangelization is their specialty, this training can be applied to pretty much any situation you may find yourself in - at work, at home, at the gym, in the neighborhood - it's easy and it's fun. So, whether you want to start a St. Paul Street Evangelization chapter and go out on the street to evangelize, or just want to get a conversation going with a family member or co-worker, this workshop is for you.

Basic Evangelization Training I will be Friday night, July 10th, from 6:30 - 9:00. Basic Evangelization Training II will be Saturday, July 11th, from 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM. The cost is \$40 if you register online, \$50 at the door. That cost includes lunch on Saturday. "From the Pastor's Desk"

During my time away at the Beach, I had the chance to read 4 books! Three of them were gifts from Parishioners ... and all were amazing. One of them, **"The Church of Mercy"** was a 2014 compilation of Pope Francis' insights concerning God's lavish Mercy ... which I'll share with you in my homilies as we enter **the Year of Mercy** on December 8th.

Now, another book that I received as a gift was entitled, **"The Complete Guide to Money"** by Dave Ramsey. It was outstanding! It's the book that should be required reading for all High School Seniors! Why? Because in it author, **Dave Ramsey** has the nerve to call **"DEBT"** what it is ... bad!

Imagine that ... to label something that our culture calls "good" ... to be exactly the opposite! Debt is BAD!

You see, we live in a consumer society where the goal of business is to get you, the consumer, to buy their products ... whether you can afford them or not.

They want you to just put it on the card ... and go in debt! So, our kids learn from an early age that it's not about how much something costs ... all that matters is whether or not you can make the monthly payments!

it's based solely on **how much you love DEBT!**

If debt is part of your life and you're longing for financial peace, then I strongly suggest you purchase Dave Ramsey's book and follow his simple suggestions. The chapters cover all aspects of money including giving to God, paying for college, and saving for retirement. And you'll be inspired by the many testimonials provided by people just like you who have successfully gotten out of debt.
