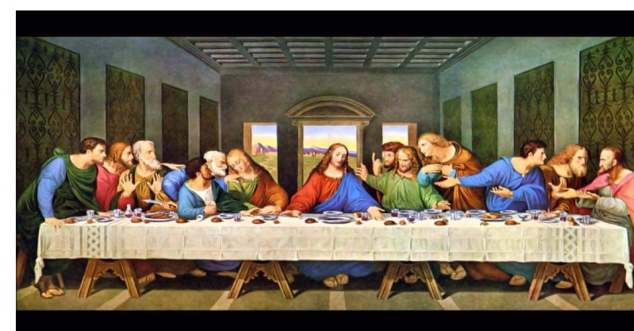
Friday Mass & Stations of the Cross
