“From the Pastor’s Desk”

When was the last time you thanked your Guardian Angel? Do you realize that you have one ... your very own angel ... created by God ... just for you ... to accompany you every day ... everywhere you go ... throughout your entire life?

Well, you do! And how unfortunate it would be for you go through your whole life and never realize that you have such a gift.

You know, there continues to be an ongoing fascination with Angels in our culture. Merchandizers like to portray them on coffee mugs and calendars ... and it's easy to dismiss them as cute little imaginings.

But the truth is that Angels are real creatures of God who are invisible to us because they are pure spirits. And even though we can't see them, they're busy at work communicating God's will and overcoming the assaults of the devil.
