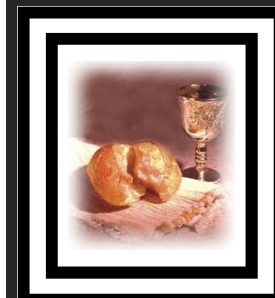

Got mail? I'm quite sure you did ... namely a letter from **Bishop Baker** and **Fr. Donohoe** ... asking for your financial support of our **Annual Catholic Charities Appeal for 2016**.

This has proven to be a **very effective way ...**
to thank God for His many blessings, and
to help those in need.

As Catholics, we're used to that special moment ... in the middle of every Sunday Mass ... called the Offertory ... where we place our offering in the Collection Basket.

That offering is used for the support of this particular Parish Church. But the need for support is so much greater ... as it spans across our whole diocese ... and that need is addressed with the contributions made to Catholic Charities.

Both of those are occasions where we can open our **hearts and wallets** to contribute a portion of the income we have received from our labors.

When we do this, we are expressing our gratitude to **God** for His many blessings and we're acting to help those in need.

If you're already doing this, I thank you sincerely, and ask you to continue to fund this important work again next year.

If you're not contributing to Catholic Charities, I ask you to begin ... by pledging your support for the year 2016.

Our Parish goal for funding Catholic Charities for next year is **\$60,000**. This is attainable only if everyone helps out. We've been blessed to make our goal every year, not because we're a rich parish ... but because we're a generous parish!
